Founded in 2022 in response to the full-scale war against Ukraine, a group of active Belgian citizens launched a volunteer initiative to support Ukrainian refugees arriving in Belgium with clothing, food, hygiene items, and other essentials.

What began as an action of volunteers soon evolved into the Brussels-based nonprofit organisation Action Ukraine EU.

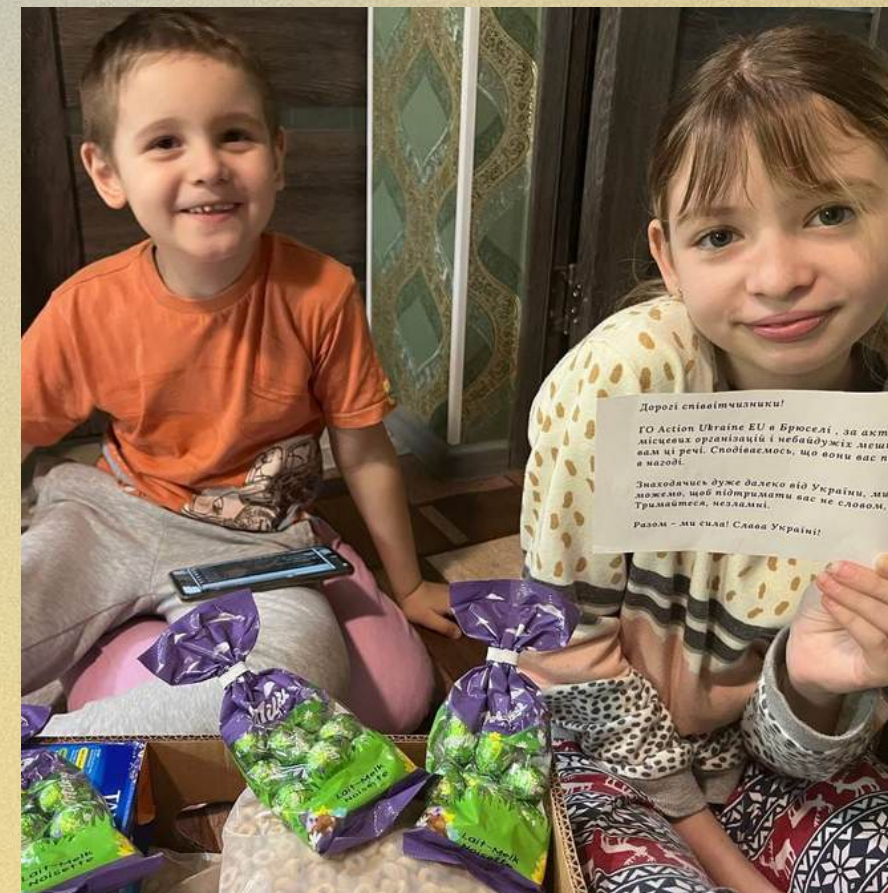

Today, Action Ukraine EU unites over 30 dedicated volunteers providing daily assistance to Ukrainian refugees. With the support of the Belgian public sector and Belgian businesses, our mission has expanded to delivering humanitarian aid, medical supplies, and food to people affected by the war in Ukraine — including children, displaced families, hospital patients, elderly people, and large families.

OUR IMPACT - CHILDREN

2,484 Ukrainian children

in need received food, clothing, hygiene products, medication, backpacks, strollers and toys from Action Ukraine EU



OUR IMPACT - HOSPITALS

Aid delivered to hospitals includes:

Stretchers, wheelchairs, medical gowns, masks, antiseptics, diapers, medications etc.



OUR IMPACT - ELDERLY PEOPLE

We support one of the most vulnerable groups in Ukraine by directly delivering essential supplies and food to elderly people through our network of local volunteers.



OUR IMPACT - LARGE FAMILIES

Many large families and families with disabled children have been forced from their homes by occupation and now live on the edge of poverty.

Providing them with essential support is one of the priorities of Action Ukraine EU.



OUR IMPACT - UKRAINIAN DEFENDERS

We provide Ukrainian soldiers with humanitarian supplies, including food, thermal clothing, body warmers, hygiene products for women, stretchers, and spare clothing for hospitalis

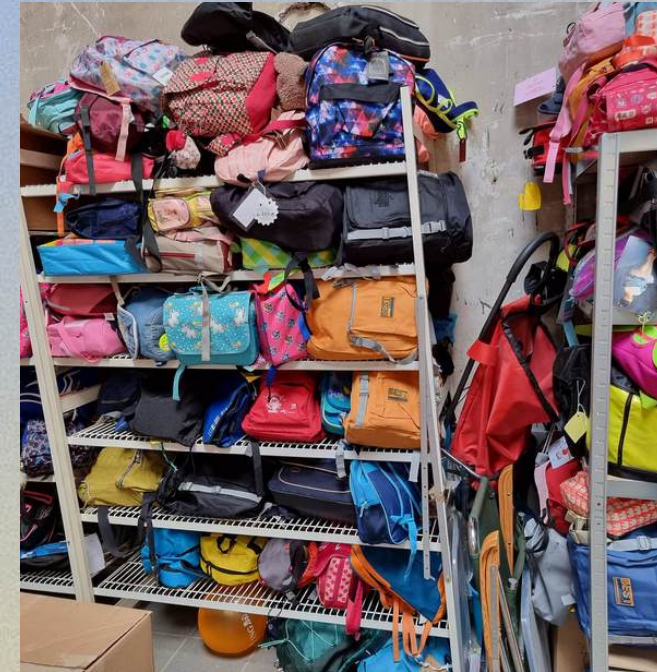


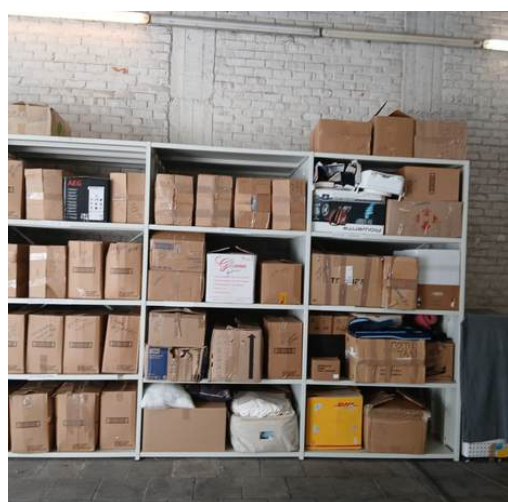
OUR IMPACT - REFUGEES

The Action Ukraine EU warehouse in Brussels serves as a vital hub for welcoming and supporting Ukrainian refugees arriving in Belgium, as well as a distribution centre for humanitarian aid sent to Ukraine.

Over the past years, we have provided refugees with free clothing, school supplies, food, toys, hygiene products, and other essential items.

Action Ukraine EU plays a crucial role in easing the arrival of Ukrainians in Brussels, offering informational and adaptation support, and helping to reduce the burden on Belgian authorities and local services.

CALL FOR HELP

Since February 2022, Action Ukraine EU has been providing urgent humanitarian aid to Ukrainians in Belgium and in Ukraine. Through our volunteer team, we have supported thousands of families, children, elderly people, and other vulnerable groups with food, clothing, hygiene products, medical supplies, and essential items.

To continue this vital work, we urgently need premises in Brussels to store, repack, and dispatch aid. The space requirements are simple: electricity, water, a toilet, 40–60 m² for storage and delivery, and 10–15 m² for packing parcels. The condition of the premises is not critical, but it is essential that the space is provided free of charge, as our organisation operates entirely on a volunteer basis.

Support that goes from the heart becomes action. Your support would directly enable us to reach families with disabled children, large families, the elderly, hospitals, orphaned children, and displaced persons—softening their hardship and giving them hope. Every parcel we send, every kit we distribute, makes a tangible difference.
